

# BURY MRS. DAVIS-HAYES.

Ashes of Daughter of Jefferson Davis  
Rest in Colorado.

COLORADO SPRINGS, Col., July 21.—All that is mortal of Mrs. Margaret Howell Jefferson Davis-Hayes, a tiny urn of ashes, rests in the little vault in Evergreen Cemetery here. The final rites over the daughter of Jefferson Davis were simple.

The residence, overlooking the campus of Colorado College, was crowded with friends of the family. In the throng on the streets were hundreds of Southerners.

The Rev. A. C. Hedrick, assistant rector of St. Stephen's Church, officiated, assisted by the Rev. Henry Rutgers Remsen of Grace Episcopal Church. The coffin was carried from the house by young men.

All the members of the immediate family were present at the funeral. They were J. Addison Hayes, the husband; Mrs. Varina Hayes Webb, Jefferson Hayes Davis, Miss Lucy Hayes, and William Hayes, children. Dr. Gerald B. Webb, son-in-law, and the grandchildren were also present.

It is probable that the ashes will be taken to Richmond, Va., in October, and that they will be accompanied by Mr. Hayes and all of the members of his family.
